## "JOURNEY THROUGH THE HOLY LAND" - Part 2

## IMPORTANT NEW TESTAMENT EVENTS THAT OCCURRED IN JERUSALEM:

- \* Jesus was brought here to be circumcised in the temple when He was eight days old (Luke 2:22)
- \* Jesus cleansed the temple (John 2:13-22)
- \* Jesus' conversation with Nicodemus (John 3:1-21)
- \* Jesus made His triumphal entry (Matthew 21:1-17)
- \* The city rejected Jesus and His ministry (Matthew 23:37-39)
- \* Here the Lord instituted the Lord's Supper on the night before His crucifixion (Matthew 26:17-30)
- \* The trial of Jesus occurred here (Matthew 26:47-27:50)
- \* After the Lord's resurrection, He appeared to disciples in Jerusalem (Luke 24:33-49; John 20:19-28)
- \* The city where Christianity was born (Acts 2:1-41)
- \* Peter and John were imprisoned there (Acts 4:1-21; 5:17-42)
- \* Stephen was the first Christian martyred here (Acts 7:1-60)
- \* Herod executed James (Acts 12:1-2)

## **IMPORTANT LOCATIONS IN OR NEAR JERUSALEM:**

### Bethesda

\* A pool surrounded by five porches where Jesus healed a man who had been crippled for 38 years (John 5:1-9)

## Gehenna

- \* Gehenna is the Greek word for the Hebrew name "Valley of Ben Hinnom."
- \* Its name was changed because of wickedness (Jeremiah 7:30-34)
- \* Gehenna is the word used for hell in passages like Matthew 5:22,29,30 and James 3:6

# Golgotha

- \* Also called "Calvary" (KJV) and "the Skull" in the NIV (Luke 23:33)
- \* It was located outside the city (Matthew 27:32,33; Mark 15:22)

#### **Mount Moriah**

- \* The mountain upon which Abraham was to offer Isaac (Genesis 22:1-4)
- \* It was also the site of the threshing floor of Araunah which David purchased as a place of worship (2 Samuel 24:18-25)
- \* This later became the site of Solomon's temple (2 Chronicles 3:1-2)

## **Mount of Olives**

- \* It was located on the east side of Jerusalem (Ezekiel 11:23)
- \* It was a Sabbath's day's walk from Jerusalem (Acts 1:12)
- \* The Lord wept over Jerusalem from here (Luke 19:41-44)
- \* It was here that Jesus prophesied the destruction of Jerusalem (Matthew 24, 25)
- \* The Lord lived at night here during His last week (Luke 21:37)
- \* After Passover, Jesus and the disciples came here (Matthew 26:30; Mark 14:26)
- \* At the foot of the mount was Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed and was arrested (Mark 14:36-46)
- \* From this location, Jesus ascended back to Heaven (Acts 1:9-12)

## Pool of Siloam

\* A man was healed of his blindness when he washed in this pool (John 9)
